Led by a team of extremely passionate and dedicated people, working side by side, hours on end, has resulted in what we can proudly say a collection of watches that is as sustainable as possible, from all natural German organic eco leathers containing no environmental harmful substances, to carefully selected and crafted FSC-certified wood and FSC-certified paper with soya-based ink for the packaging.

In a rapidly changing and often stressful world, we wanted to develop a collection that transports you and reminds you of nature's wonderful smells and textures through the richness of smooth wood and soft organic leathers.

You may have forgotten what the cool shade of trees feels like or the grass beneath your feet, the warm sunlight on your skin, or simply the sound of rustling leaves. With Jacques Farel hayfield,

it is time to feel again.

This booklet is more than just a manual with a guarantee. It has been written with the upmost transparency, a vital ingredient for any sustainable product, and you will find here everything you need to know about your Jacques Farel hayfield watch and how to care for it properly.

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How do I set the time?

(ORW series)

Setting the time

Pull out the crown to the first position as shown on the drawing. Turn the crown to set the hour and minute. Push the crown back into the normal position.

Setting the day of the week and the time

The day of the week and the time (hour, 24-hour, minute, second) are set as follows:

Adjusting the day of the week

Pull the crown out to the second position as shown on the drawing. Turn the hour and minute hands clockwise to set the desired day. To set the day of the week, you must turn the hour hand by 24 hours per day intervals.

Note: *If the day of the week is set by turning the crown in the counterclockwise direction, the date cannot be changed.

Do not set the day of the week by turning the crown in the counterclockwise direction.

*The day of the week switches between 0:00 and 4:30am.

Setting the time

Once the day of the week has been selected, set the hour (and 24 hour) as well as the minute. Turn the hour and minute hands clockwise to set the time. After setting the time, press the crown back to the normal position to start the second hand.

Note: *Make sure you have the correct setting for morning / afternoon

Setting the date (quick option)

Pull the crown out to the first position. Turn the crown anticlockwise to set the date quickly.

Note: *Do not set the date between 9:00pm and 0:30am. Otherwise, the date may not change the next day.

Why and what is Eco leather?

To choose real natural eco leather from Germany means making a deliberate choice to opt for one of the finest materials nature has on offer. Each strap is also padded using a natural cork material and stitched with yarn certified to the strictest Ökotex 100 standard. The eco leather uses vegetable and renewable substances for tanning, ensuring the leather remains a beautiful and safe product of nature.

The strap's natural leather lining was also carefully selected from Germany as it is soft, and tanned with pure vegetable agents, making it particularly breathable and kind to the skin.

Tanning

Renewable substances for tanning are used instead of customary chrome components. Every strap crafted from this vegetable tanned leather matures to an individual one-of-a-kind piece by light, time and touch.

Coloring

The colors are free of any heavy metals and without chrome. All dyes have been certified by the International Association of Natural Textiles (IVN), the Association of Organic Agriculture and the ECARF (European Centre for Allergy Research Foundation). The IVN certification is rated as the most sophisticated textile label among environmentalists and consumer protection groups and the ECARF has for the first time certified a leather as "allergy-friendly".

Surface treatment

The leather is neither tanned nor coated with harmful substances. The leather has authentic natural features which underline the authenticity and characteristics of the leather and offers every watch a one-of-a-kind character.

One-of-a-kind

Special features on the hide are far too beautiful to be covered and made to disappear. These unique leather characteristics have been built by nature. That is why we selected leathers showing these features. These natural characteristics are not "flaws", but the confirmation that the leathers are a genuine natural product.

Light effect

As time goes by, natural tanned leathers change their colors under the influence of light. This is a natural process, which varies with the duration and intensity of light as well as the characteristics of the respective leather color. Except for models ORW 1001 and ORW 1005 which may darken, all leather straps can become slightly lighter.

Color Rubbing

Due to the nature of the tanning and the absence of industrial coating substances, color rubbing can occur on textiles or other materials, when leather is humid or wet. Although color rubbing is generally very low, it can still occur.

What wood are we using?

For Jacques Farel hayfield, we have carefully selected maple and walnut wood. Both woods are FSC-certified. The FSC (Forest Stewardship Council ®) symbol stands for transparency and credibility worldwide. FSC is a global, not-for-profit organization dedicated to the promotion of responsible forest management worldwide and enables consumers to make informed choices about the forest products they buy.

What is in my watch?

The ORW series has a Miyota Super 2035 movement. It complies with the EU RoHS Directive (Restriction of Hazardous Substances), which restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The battery for this movement is mercury free and has a life-span of about 4 years. With a (+/-) 15 seconds deviation per month, this Japan made movement runs precisely and accurately.

The ORM series has a Miyota 6P29 movement. It complies with the EU RoHS Directive (Restriction of Hazardous Substances), which restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The battery of this movement is mercury free and has a life-span of about 3 years. The deviation per month is approximately (+/-) 20 seconds.

Proper care

Natural leather can be cleaned if it has dust and/ or dirt using a soft, dry or damp cloth. As a reminder, natural leather does not have any chemical coating and can be more sensitive.

As the leather is more breathable (it does not contain industrial chemical coating), moisture and dirt can penetrate the strap. Stains can only be prevented with careful handling. Stains cannot be removed. Once the leather is wet, you should let your strap air dry slowly and naturally. Never place on a heater or oven!

Sharp-edged objects can damage / scratch the surface of the leather and should be avoided. Such damage remains permanently visible. But showing its characteristics is also what makes it one-of-a-kind.

Wood

To help protect the wood of the watch (breakage/cracks), the wood has been coated with a clear varnish. This also gives the wood a beautiful shine. This clear coating meets EU REACH regulations (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals).

This clear coating protection is far more reliable than wax as wax needs regular maintenance to protect the wood permanently. This is not necessary for your watch.

Is my watch water resistant?

All models of the ORW series are water-resistant to 30 meters, and ORM models are 50 meters water-resistant. To protect your leather straps and wood rings, we recommend that you do not expose your watch to water and suggest you avoid wearing your watch when bathing or showering. We also recommend you to remove your watch during exercise. Due to the nature of the leather, color rubbing may occur with perspiration. But the percentage is generally very low.

Watch Disposal

As your watch reaches the end of its life span, it should not be disposed in normal household waste, since many parts are recyclable. The symbol of the "crossed out waste bin logo" on the packaging reminds you of this. Please contact your local municipality with regards to the available recycling disposal centers for electrical and electronic equipment. This will help make an important contribution to the protection of our environment.



Battery disposal

Old batteries should not be disposed in normal household waste. Batteries can also be recycled. Please contact your local municipality to find out more details on how to dispose safely of batteries.



Guarantee

This guarantee comes into place from the date of purchase of your watch for a period of two years.

If the watch proves to be defective in material or workmanship under normal use, it will be repaired or replaced for a same or similar watch free of charge at the discretion of the Jacques Farel service center. A return shipping and handling fee will apply to all guarantee services.

The manufacturer's guarantee does not cover: Battery, case, and strap, damage resulting from improper handling, lack of care, accidents, or normal wear and tear, repairs if the watch was not originally purchased from an authorized Jacques Farel retailer.

This guarantee is void if the watch has been damaged by accident, negligence, unauthorized service, or other factors not due to defects in material or workmanship.

Should your watch require guarantee or non-guarantee service, please send your watch in a small, well-padded envelope. Please send your watch only – do NOT send original packaging. Please include proof of purchase and copy of the guarantee details.

A return shipping and handling fee will apply to all guarantee and non-guarantee services.
